The Mystic Chorale is a community that shares a love of celebration, joining voices to create a living harmony that is joyful, healing, and compassionate.

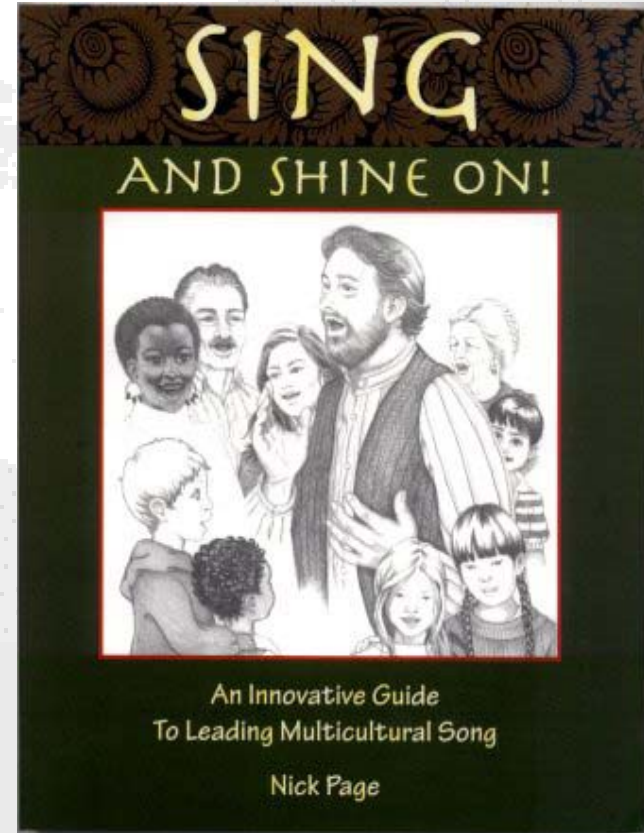
Our Mission is to:

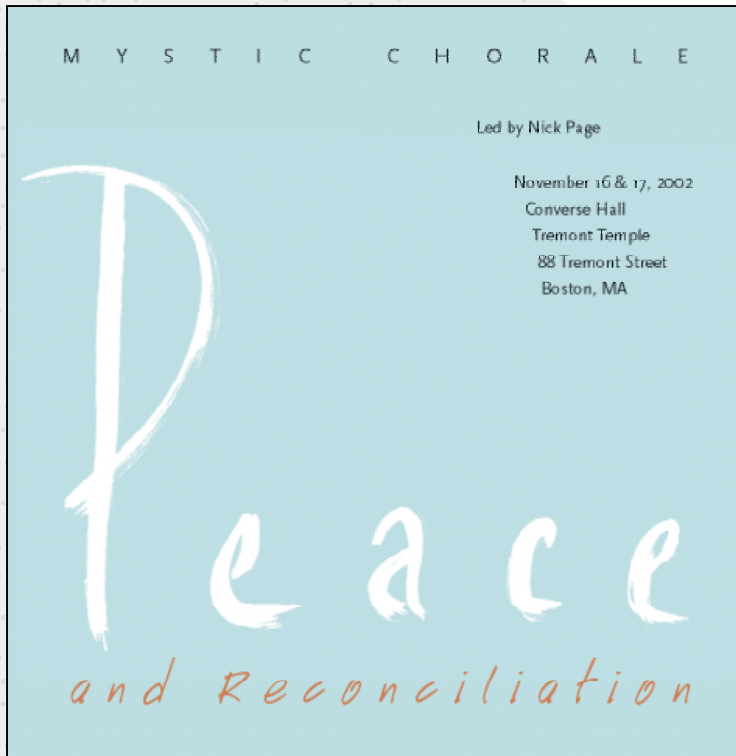
