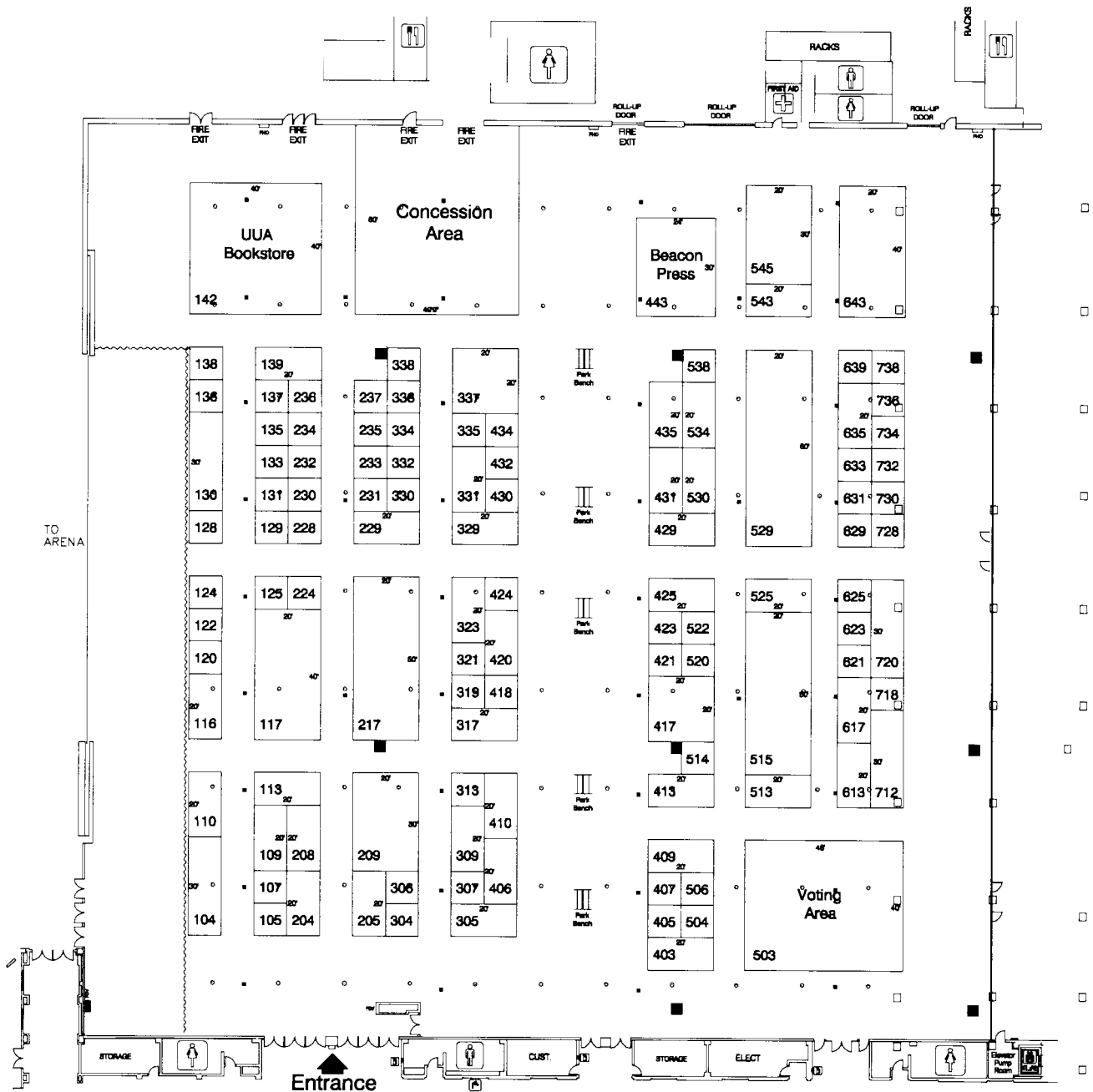

Planning Committee Sponsored Featured Presentations
