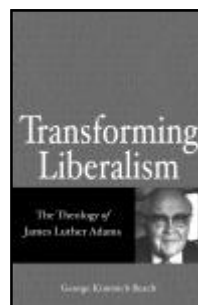


EVERYONE A BUTTERFLY *40 Sermons for Children*

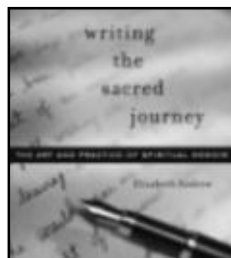
